

## SP<sup>2</sup> End User License Agreement

### **DEFINITIONS:**

"Software" shall be taken to mean the software downloaded in this zip file and any subsequent versions or upgrades received as a result of having purchased this package. The software is known as SP<sup>2</sup> (also known as "Software Package Selection Process" or "SP Squared")

"Buyer" shall be taken as the original purchaser of the software. If the Buyer is a multinational organisation, the purchase applies only to the division within the country that made the purchase
